HON 3000/W1—“Theories of Learning and Honors Research”—Dr. Raynice Jean-Sigur, Dept. of Elementary and Early Childhood Education

In this 1-credit, pass/fail Maymester course, students will learn how to connect theory to research. Based on readings and discussing key theorists, students will learn how to include a theoretical framework in honors research. Students will study and review theorists such as Piaget, Vygotsky, and Erikson. Class assignments will include a modest workload of readings, and discussions. The concluding assignment will be the development of a draft proposal for research and/or future projects in the honors program. Class discussions, assignments and course interactions will be implemented via D2L.
