



HON 4499 (0-3 credit hrs., graded): Honors Senior Capstone Experience II

HON 4499 is designed to give students pursuing the University Honors Scholar designation credit for completing, submitting, and receiving full approval for their honors thesis from their project supervisors and the Honors College. Students must make an A or a B on their thesis and successfully complete all required Honors Learning Experiences to earn designation as an Honors Scholar.

HON 4499 will be offered for 0-, 1-, 2-, or 3-credit hours. Please see your Honors Advisor to determine your credit-hour requirements for the Honors Capstone Completion course.

Students pursuing the University Honors Scholar designation who have successfully completed HON 4497 should check with their Honors College advisor regarding the number of HON 4499 credit hours they should register for in the fall.

Students pursuing the Honors in the Major designation only do not need to register for HON 4499. Honors in the Major students should complete HON 4497 prior to completing the Capstone course in their major. Successful capstone completion must be confirmed prior to graduation by their department supervisor in writing to the Honors College in order to earn the Honors in the Major designation.
